Position Overview:

Discovery Land (DL) is the Children's Ministry at Alliance Church. Parents and kids describe DL as Christ-centered, Biblically solid, relevant, fast-paced and fun! We are a nationally known Children's Ministry that focuses on the souls of the children and their need for a Biblically accurate and strong relationship with Jesus Christ! This position will lead dynamic, growing, outreached focused ministries for kids (infant-6th grade) at Alliance Church - Neenah. The estimated number of kids is 60-80.

Neenah Team Responsibilities:

- Serves as a team player to execute strategic planning, special projects, launch-related events, Core Team trainings, and other team activities.
- Neenah team members are equal contributors to Alliance Church's vision for church
 multiplication and agree to pursue multiple professional strengths and God-given spiritual
 abilities including those not specifically outlined here.
- Commits to spiritual growth through studying God's word, prayer, pursuing accountability, engaging in gospel community, and regular self-care.

- Meet with team leaders quarterly to encourage and equip them to build into volunteer teams.

- Recognize first time guests by sending personalized notes to the family
- Lead family classes such as DL baptism and Child Dedication classes (as needed)
- Provide care to families when needed.
