Most of the occasions when Jesus ate with His friends, tax collectors, or the other "undesirable" people, they were seated at an ordinary meal in an ordinary home. Most scholars believe that our Lord spent most of His time in Peter's home, which is in the city of Capernaum. If you go to Isreal today, you can visit the site of Peter's home.

The book of Acts tells us that the early church also met in people's homes, until larger numbers necessitated the need to build seperate places for worship, Bible study, and fellowship. All of this should help us remember the value of using our home when we do "ministry."
