Ezekiel records God talking to His people, saying,

"Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. Your filth will be washed away, and you will no longer worship idols. And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart. And I will put my Spirit in you so that you will follow my decrees and be careful to obey my regulations." (Ezekiel 36:25-27 NLT)

Isn't that the problem? Our hearts are just not that sensitive. The world equates strength and courage with hard-heartedness. A "softie" is someone who weeps easily or can't "handle it." But isn't that like God to desire the opposite of what the world celebrates? He desires a sensitive, tender, responsive HEART. This is a tough request to make, but when was the last time you asked God to break your heart? To soften it? Tenderize it? To replace it with one that is easily affected; a heart unable to carry the weight of even the smallest offense toward God?
