What comes out of you when you are “squeezed?” How do you respond when the pressure’s on? During WWII, a psychiatrist, who later wrote a book about his experiences, focused on the response of people in Japanese prison camps. His observation was that, at first, everybody had the same priority to “self-preserve.” However, as time passed, he noticed that people of faith began to emerge, showing great generosity and the ability to endure with dignity. He confessed that this witness challenged his presuppositions about Christianity.

How you respond when you are “squeezed” says a lot about what you really believe about God and his Sovereign Plan for our lives.
