

A Message from Rev. Brian Episcopo

Sometimes my wife and I argue. Sometimes, she hurts my feelings. Sometimes, I say something hurtful back. Why? I want her to hurt the way that I am hurting. It's that ugly. She may not understand all that and may simply return fire for fire. Sometimes, I think we treat God this way. When God hurts our feelings by not "being there" in a way WE expected Him to be, we respond. We respond by living in a way that we KNOW is contrary to His values. We try to "hurt Him back" for allowing us to be hurt. But God does not "fight" back the way people do. He is not insecure, threatened by our sinful response. If this is your life, hear me: God is not winding up to hit you back harder than you "hit Him." Instead, He knows your pain! He understands why you tried to "hurt Him!" And like the Father, in Luke 15, He waits for you to "come home" so He can quickly celebrate "finding" you as though He never stopped looking ALL ALONG (Luke 15:24).
